Finally, take your signed form and your freshman folder (housed with your freshman advisor, in Sweet Hall, or with your current major department) to the Student Services Office. You can then declare psychology as your major on Axess.

Psychology Major Requirements:

- Psych 1 and Psych 10 (or a comparable Statistics course)
- At least five core courses, with a minimum of two from each area A and B. Area A: 20, 30, 45, 55. Area B: 60, 70, 75, 80, 90, or 95. Students may count only one transfer course toward fulfilling the core course requirement.
- A total of 70 units of psychology including courses listed above. No more than 10 units (15 for honors students and/or teaching assistants) of independent study, research, and practica may be counted toward the 70 unit requirement. At least 28 units must be completed at Stanford.
- Out of the 70 required units, 10 units may be pre-approved courses outside of the Psychology department. Your faculty advisor or the student services office must approve the outside courses you take. If you decide to change this plan and the outside units, you need to resubmit this form.
- All courses must be passed with a letter grade of 'C-' or better (except for courses offered only on a satisfactory/no credit basis).
- One writing intensive (Writing in the Major or WIM) course. (Mark the column next to the course to indicate the WIM)
- The department strongly recommends that all majors take at least one seminar.
